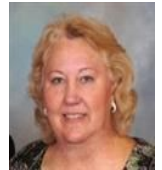

Any N.E.W. sister who has been a member in good standing for at least two years is encouraged to apply.
Recipient must:

- Outline what scholarship money will be used for specifically and how it will assist in furthering her career or in a career change. Funds must be used for continuing education at a college / seminar / tech center.
- Must remain a member of N.E.W. at least one year after scholarship has been awarded.
- Preference given to candidates with strong participation in Who Knew, Board Service, Committee Work, and/or other Volunteer activities.

Each applicant must submit an essay that meets specifications (all essays must be double spaced using a 12 point font size and must not exceed two pages in length) and answers the following question:

What business person do you admire most and how has she/he *personally* influenced the direction of your life?

Please provide contact information for two business / professional references.

N. E. W. candidate essays and documentation of above mentioned criteria are **due on or before, Friday June 1, 2018**. Please mail completed application and supporting documentation to:
